ASDER ELECTS ITS NEW BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Salvadorian Association of Broadcasters (ASDER) elected the members of its new Board of Directors for the term in Office 2013 – 2015 in their General Assembly. Eng. José Luis Saca Jiménez was elected President.

During this activity, the outgoing President Dr. Pedro Leonel Moreno Monge received a homage and a plaque in recognition for his career. He was in service for two consecutive terms, during which the institution was strengthened, the activities for the defense of freedom of expression were deepened and the membership development was broadened.

ASDER new President committed himself to strengthen the work carried out, mainly on the field of the defense of freedoms and of the principles governing private and free broadcasting.

Engineer Saca Jiménez assumes office at a very important moment for ASDER, because for the next few days we are planning the “International Festival of Radio and Television “ from May 15 to 17 which will become a continental event for the defense of Freedom of Expression .
